HOW TO REGISTER

<u>Registering for services</u> through the RCPD is as easy as 1, 2, 3!

- Formally identify as a student or employee with a physical, sensory, cognitive or psychological disability via <u>RCPD's MyProfile</u> web portal.
- 2. Once you've requested to register through MyProfile, an RCPD Access Specialist will contact you through your MSU email to request disability <u>documentation</u>.
- **3.**Once sufficient <u>documentation</u> is received, the specialist will contact you to set up a needs assessment to fully discuss accommodation requests. When this is complete, you will receive an <u>Accommodation Letter</u> that you share with your instructors.
